Dear TTPost Tobago Customers,

The spread of the COVID-19 pandemic throughout the country has temporarily reduced the Trinidad and Tobago Postal Corporation's (TTPost's) capacity for service delivery and therefore forced the Corporation to make changes to the distribution of pension and other social welfare cheques to customers, including those who usually receive these cheques out of its Scarborough and Bon Accord outlets, while meeting its delivery deadline.

September 2020 cheques which are usually distributed via the Scarborough and Bon Accord Outlets will be distributed from 8.00 a.m. to 3.00 p.m. as follows:
