EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI)

TRANSFORMATION OF THE TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO POSTAL CORPORATION (TTPOST)

The following are responses to questions posed by possible proponents of the aforementioned EOI:

Question #1.

Can companies subcontract or be included as a group of companies bidding for the tender?

Answer # 1.

Proponents may provide submissions as consortia, but must provide information on all participating partners equivalent to the submission requirements in section 9.0 of the EOI.

Also, proponents may provide submission as Lead Consultants with other entities as Sub-consultants with specified roles. However, Lead Consultants must maintain and cannot transfer technical and financial responsibility for all output and ensuing outcomes of the consultancy.

Question # 2.

What is the reason and therefore the weighting of international postal reform being part of the TOR instead of change management, business process and model innovation as the key deliverable regardless of sector? Hence are 9.3 and 7.3 applicable?

Answer # 2.

Sections 9.3 and 7.3 are part of the requirements of the Terms of Reference (TOR). Local or International Firms and/or Individuals having postal sector reform experience will be considered an asset to this consultancy.

Section 9.4 *"List of Transformation, Change Management or Business Re-engineering projects of similar scope, scale and complexity completed within the past 10 years"* is also a requirement of the TOR. Local or International Firms and/or Individuals having this experience will be considered an asset to this consultancy.
