

## PUBLIC NOTICE

The Trinidad and Tobago Postal Corporation wishes to advise the residents and business owners of Trinidad and Tobago that it is currently implementing a new addressing standard called the S42. This standard is the internationally recognized addressing format used by developed nations, and would place Trinidad and Tobago as one of 29 countries in the world with certification and the only Caribbean nation to attain this recognition. Implementing this standard will result in the standardization of addresses and the elimination of indigenous addressing elements such as 'Lamp Post #', 'Mile Marker #' and 'Corner of' formats. All addresses in Trinidad and Tobago will now be standardized to reflect the building number, street name, community name and postal district, post code and country name.

In keeping with the Corporation's commitment to operating with international standards, a Postal Code System has also been developed for Trinidad and Tobago. As such, TTPost in conjunction with the Municipal Corporations has embarked on an extensive Address Improvement and Postal Code Implementation Project within the corporations starting with a numbering and /or re-numbering of streets that are inconsistently numbered.

This upgrade in addressing format would not only facilitate better service to you, our customers, but also aid in the continued development of Trinidad & Tobago as proper addressing is an integral part of infrastructural development.

As a result, we are kindly requesting your support as our team visits your area to collect and disseminate addressing information.

**Please note that this initiative does not change or affect your land or lot numbers.** Our aim is to improve mailing addresses by assignment of new or amended house numbers and postal codes in a systematic manner.
